

Court clerks urge better standards

The Missouri Association for Court Administration, an organization of court clerks, will try to establish a qualification program for certifying court clerks at their next annual meeting May 25 through May 27 at the Lodge of the Four Seasons at the Lake of the Ozarks.

The association was established in May 1986 and has a membership of 128 court clerks from around the state. They meet each year in conjunction with the Missouri Municipal and Associate Circuit Judges Association and the State Court Administrator's Office in Jefferson City.

Doris J. Parcel, court clerk in Auxvasse, is serving as a director for the association and is co-chairman of the education committee.

The association is working with the Missouri Institute for Executive Development at the University of Missouri-Columbia to establish a continuing education program for court clerks to become certified.
