SUBJECT: PROPOSED BY-LAWS CHANGE

Dear Member,

Listed below is the proposed change we will be voting on at our annual meeting. After the proposed change I have listed the current by-law.

Article III Membership - This would be changed to read "Associate membership may be granted to any person engaged in an allied field and related to the work of the Court and its administration. A clerk serving his or her court or another court in a judicial or prosecution role would be in this membership classification. An associate member may serve on a committee in an advisory capacity, upon approval of the Executive Board." Currently this reads "Associate membership may be granted to any person engaged in an allied field and related to the work of the Court and its administration. An associate member may serve on a committee in an advisory capacity, upon approval of the Executive Board."

Article X Effective Date - this would be changed to reflect the new effective date of the current by-laws should the above proposed change be approved.
