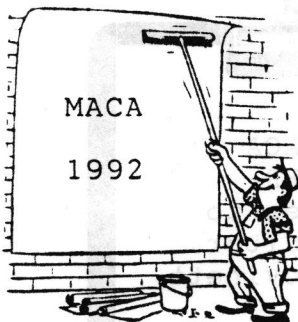

The theme for the HOSPITALITY ROOM is HAWAIIAN and if you dress in Hawaiian wardrobe, you will get a ticket for a special drawing.

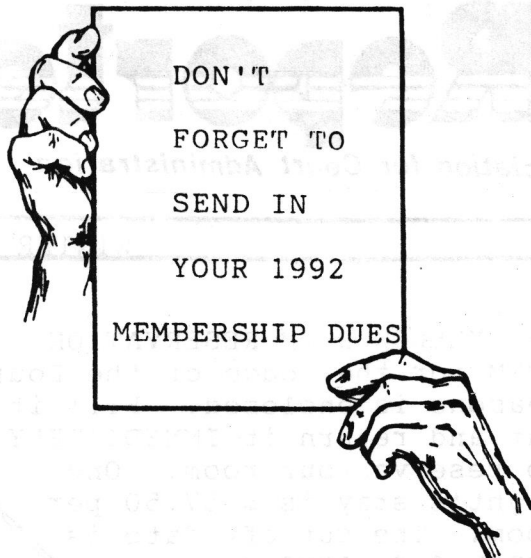

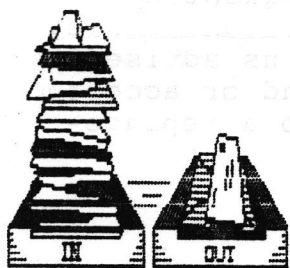

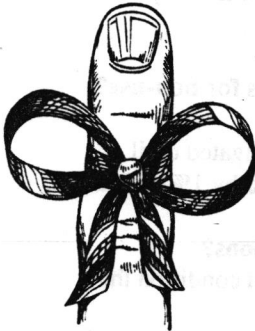

Child Restraint Law

When was it effective:

- The child restraint law is currently in effect.
- It became effective January 1, 1984.

Who must be secured in a child safety seat?

- All children under four riding in the front seat of a vehicle.
- Children under four riding in the rear may substitute a seat belt.

Who must comply with the law?

- All residents of Missouri.

Who is responsible:

- Any person transporting a child under the age of four.

What are the penalties for non-compliance?

- A fine of up to \$25 may be imposed.

What are the exemptions?

- The law does not apply to temporary or substitute vehicle.
- Does not apply to public carrier for hire.

What is an approved child safety seat:

- A car seat that was manufactured after January 1, 1981, and has the approval of Federal Safety Standard 213.

Seat Belt Law

What are the effective dates?

- The law became effective September 28, 1985.
- Fines have been imposed since July 1, 1987.

Who must be secured by a seat belt?

- All front seat occupants.
- All children under four: in an approved child safety seat in the front, or at least a seat belt in the rear.

Who is responsible and subject to a fine?

- The driver is responsible for passengers under the age of 16.
- Passengers 16 and over are responsible for themselves.

What are the penalties for non-use?

- A fine up to \$10.
- Non-use can reduce litigated civil damage claims awarded by 1% maximum.

What are the exemptions?

- Medical - for physical condition that prevents use of belt.
- Occupants of autos manufactured prior to 1968.
- Postal carriers delivering mail from vehicle.
- Vehicles designed to carry more than ten persons; trucks and cycles.
