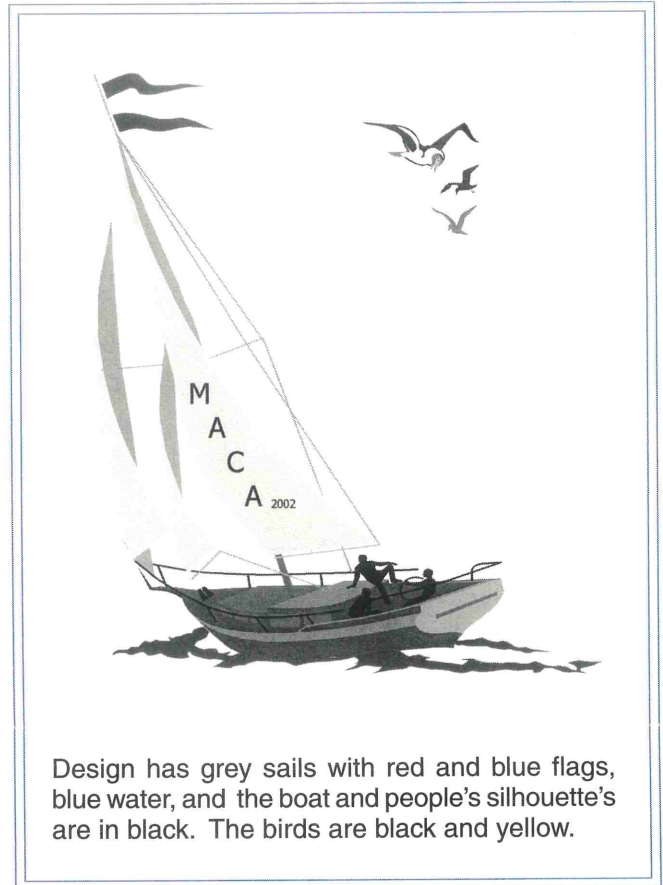

The theme for the Midyear Conference is "**Best Practices in Overcoming Unequal Treatment in the Justice System**". Plenary speakers include:

Bill Irwin, who, with his seeing eye dog Orient, is the only blind person to have completed the 2,168 mile Appalachian Trail. This experience and encounters as a family counselor allow him to make life-changing observations which translate into eventual life-changing decisions in the lives of every person in his audiences.

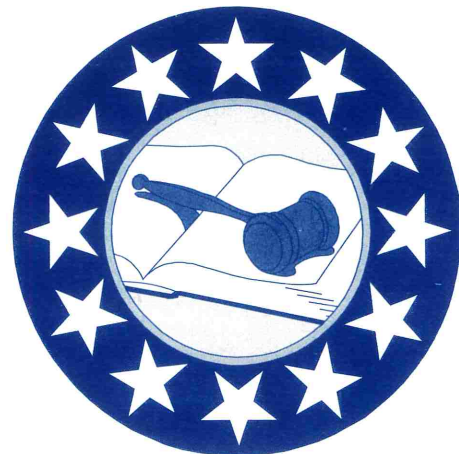
